
Mr. Mooney mentioned a complaint that was filed regarding heavy equipment in the wetlands. Mr. Mooney stated that he had reached out to the owner. The owner of the junk yard had hired a consultant to go down and investigate the site. The commission is hopeful that they will be receiving an update by the next March meeting. They discussed the applicant is responsible for returning a suitable mitigation proposal.

Concerns regarding survey flags on Maguire Avenue was brought to the Commissions attention. The Commission looked at the sight briefly and found nothing.

A potential buyer is looking for wetland information for a lot on Walnut Terrace.

The Commission received fact sheets from Mass Audubon regarding nature values, wetland, waterways, animals, grasslands, and farmlands. Superseding the determination of ability from the DEP regarding the railroad and the Avon water supply. The Commission decided to table this topic till the full commission is present.
