Avon Park and Recreation met at 6:30pm with members Carl Fischer, Dan Hart, Ben Chapman, Stephen McCarthy, Barbara Littlefield and Summer Program Director Jennifer Mayo present.

The board waived the reading of the July 10, 2018 minutes until our next meeting on August 7, 2018.

STOYAC BASKETBALL SIGNUPS

The board met with STOYAC representative George Dolinsky to discuss basketball signups for Avon residents in grades 2nd-12th. Parents can register their child on-line at www.stoyac.org or at the Avon Civic Center on Monday, September 17th from 6pm-7:30pm. The board requested Jen Mayo obtain a School Use Form to request use of the Avon Middle High School gymnasium. George showed the board the flyer to distribute to the Avon Public Schools and also be placed in the Moneysaver. Dan Hart mentioned he would create a Facebook event to promote the sign-up event and discussed having the flyer promoted on the Avon cable channel.

BUTLER PLAYGROUND SWINGS

Dan Hart spoke with John from Creative Recreation and received a quote of \$1,100.00 to replace all 10 swings at the Butler School playground. Dan motioned the board order the 10 swings and an additional 10 replacement swings. After discussion with all board members, Barbara Littlefield motioned to purchase 10 new swings and chains this year with the plan to order 5 new replacement swings in fiscal year 2020. SUMMER PROGRAM COUNCILOR PAYRATES

Jen Mayo brought up a concern one of the summer councilors had about an incorrect payrate. The board investigated the payrates of the councilors and discovered the rates are correct.

FAMILY MOVIE NIGHT

Ben Chapman is designing a flyer for Family Movie Night and is working to finalize the details of food to be served.

Dan Hart informed the board the school permit has been approved and that the Call Firefighters Association will be donating and serving popcorn during the event.

Jen Mayo confirmed the summer program councilors will be available to run activities during the event. They have also been taking pictures of the children participating at the summer program for a slideshow that will be played before the start of the movie. The ice cream truck will also be present at the event at 6:30pm.

Barbara made a motion to approve the quote from BC Tent of \$517.65 for a 20x20 tent, 50 chairs and four 60 inch round tables. Stephen 2nd the motion will all members in favor. The board discussed securing a police detail for the event from the hours of 6pm-10pm.
