**Miller Tracy mural/playground**

Vice Chairman Chapman updated the Board that DPW has fixed the broken fence at the Miller Tracy playground. Recreation Director Mayo will follow up with DPW to discuss the playground inspection report for the Miller Tracy playground.

### **Tennis Courts**

Chairman Hart updated the Board on a meeting with the Town Administrator, the next steps for the Bartlett Street project include a survey for residents, a public meeting, and researching grant opportunities available to help with funding the project.

Vice Chairman Chapman will follow up with the DPW Director on Fagan Drive as a possible location for a basketball court.

Commissioner Kovick suggested the Board reach out to DPW to clean up overgrown brush at the tennis courts, on the West Main Street side.

Recreation Director Mayo will update the Board when the proposal from Sport Court MA is received.

### **Department Head meeting update**

End of the year budget process was discussed.

### **Summer Program**

Recreation Director Mayo updated the Board on the Summer Program, the first week went well. We welcomed over 125 kids on opening day and our first field trip of the summer to Nova Trampoline was a great success.

### **Community Movie Night (CMN)**

Recreation Director Mayo updated the Board on plans for CMN thus far, 2 Box 2 Go will offer their slush cart and snacks for CMN; however, they are no longer running their food truck, the Avon Civic Association will work to secure the National Guard to offer games, and we are waiting on final approval on the use of space request for Butler. Recreation Director Mayo will complete the flyer and work to choose a movie title.

Recreation Director Mayo shared information and sample menus from Deag's Diner, out of Stoughton, as a possible food truck option for CMN. They will charge a four hundred fee to cover gas, staff, and permitting. The payment process will need to be confirmed with the vendor.

Vice Chair Chapman made a motion to book Deag's food truck for CMN, scheduled for Saturday, August 6, 2022, dependent on availability, minimum fee, menu, and payment process. Commissioner Kovick second the motion. Commissioner Kovick voted aye. Vice Chairman Chapman voted aye. Chairman Hart voted aye. The motion carried.

### **Fall/Winter ideas**

The Board discussed possible fall and winter ideas, including: a joint Christmas event with Avon Civic Association and Avon public library, goat yoga, t-shirt contest, and a Thanksgiving scavenger hunt.
