

Single Stream Recycling

WHAT IS SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING?

Single stream recycling is when all the items that we recycle go into the same container. **There is no longer any reason to separate the glass, plastic, paper, boxes and put them into separate containers...** Just put all the items into one container. The recycling facility separates the items.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

*Please rinse out all food containers!



- Plastic-Containers #1-7 *with* bottleneck only (All colors, 2 gallon or less)
- Old Corrugated Boxes-Cardboard (No Pizza Boxes)
- Glass-Food and Beverage Containers (Brown, Blue, Clear or Green)
- Tin and Steel Cans
- Paper-Newspaper, Office Paper, White Paper, Colored Paper
- Junk Mail (Window Envelopes and Inserts are OK)
- Brown Paper Bags
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Cereal Boxes (please remove plastic liner)
- Telephone Books
- Aluminum-Foil, Food & Beverage Containers
- Empty Aerosol Cans (No Flammable Liquids)



NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:



- Pizza Boxes
- Styrofoam
- Plastics #1-7 *without* a bottleneck (Tubs, Lids, Cups, Containers, Toys)
- Stickers, Labels and backings
- Auto Glass or Ceramics
- Batteries
- Film Canisters
- Light Bulbs
- Wood
- Paper Towels, Plates, Cups
- Plastic Grocery Bags (Please return to supermarket)
- Plastic Film
- Porcelain
- Food Waste
- Mirrors
- Propane/Butane Canisters

AVON SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING PROGRAM
Residential Solid Waste Only. (No construction or commercial waste accepted)

- 1.) Separate trash from recyclables to avoid confusion. Place all recyclables in the recycling bin.
- 2.) If there are more recyclables that will fit in the container, place them in a suitable, clearly labeled receptacle which can be readily identified for the collectors.
- 3.) Trash and recyclables must be placed at curb side before 7:00 a.m. on your regular scheduled collection day.
- 4.) If collector leaves items in the bin, it is because they are not recyclable. Please put them in your regular trash.


