



FLU SHOT CLINIC

TO RECEIVE A FLU SHOT YOU MUST:

- Meet a minimum age requirement.
*If under 18 years of age, please see management.
- Not have a history of severe allergic reactions (e.g., anaphylaxis) to egg proteins, any vaccine components, or life-threatening reactions to a previous influenza vaccination.
- Not be exhibiting symptoms other than mild coughing, runny nose, and/or diarrhea.
- Not have a history of Guillain-Barré Syndrome.
- Meet any CDC eligibility requirements required at the date of service.

The following may be contraindication; the nurse will discuss with you prior to vaccination.

- A severe, life-threatening reaction to latex.
- An allergy to Thimerisol (used as a preservative in vaccines) and/or gelatin (used as a stabilizer in vaccines).
