KEY POSITIVES TO A NEW BUILDING

- 3 separate facilities (4 buildings) combined into one innovative structure.
- Cost savings to town budget to have one state of the art facility.
- Improves East Main Street corridor and revitalizes town center consistent with vision for Avon

WHAT IS WRONG WITH OUR CURRENT FACILITY?

- The current Town Hall facility was originally designed and constructed as a shopping center in 1968.
- The current school administrative office occupies two, single-story buildings that were originally designed and constructed in the 1960's as kindergarten classrooms.
- There have been no major renovations done to any of the current buildings. They will require significant capital improvements and extensive renovation.
- Work includes exterior envelope, interior finishes, accessibility, replacement of MEP/FP systems, asbestos remediation and on-site septic system.
- Buildings are poorly constructed with little to no energy saving features and have many life safety and building code issues.
- Expensive to operate and maintain multiple facilities.
- To renovate the current facilities, DBVW Architects have estimated it will cost between \$16-20 million
