TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Town Administrator Crimmins reported that Police Chief Martineau is busy bringing his department up to full staff. He also discussed lateral transfers. A lateral transfer would give Avon an extra officer on the street immediately.

Thank you to the Fire Department for assisting the Civic Association with hanging up holiday lighting.

Mr. Crimmins announced the "Boston Globe" will publish an article about Avon in this coming Sunday's newspaper. The Address section of the "Globe" will feature the article.

Department heads are very busy. Budgets are due in the Town Administrator's office on Friday, December 5th.

The School Department's budget is in the Board of Selectmen's mailboxes.

The Town Hall renovation is moving along. Mr. Crimmins reported he is looking into the cost of finishing the job and what the expense has been to date.

Mr. Crimmins stated he is busy with collective bargaining.

A meeting of the Finance Team was held. The meeting was scheduled to help everyone understand the FY '16 budget process.

Mr. Crimmins discussed maintenance issues and needs for the Town Hall building before the winter sets in.

Treasurer/Collector Deb Morin submitted her monthly cash balances report.

Mr. Crimmins mentioned that Veteran's benefits are running short. A transfer request will be necessary.

The Department of Public Works has worked out the glitches with the water bills. Mr. Crimmins asked the Board to consider waiving a \$25.00 late fee that was added to the water bills. The Board agreed.

Chairman Hegarty asked the Board to consider any legislation they wish to file.

At 8:00 p.m., with all business completed, Mr. Rose made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Brady seconded the motion. The motion carried.
