## Dear Sir/Madam:

On behalf of Possum's Trucking Inc, Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. (CHES) provides your office with the attached Release Notification Form (BWSC Form 103) and the conclusions of the Permanent Solution Statement as part of the public involvement process required by the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (MCP, 310 CMR 40.0000 and 40.1406). The conclusions of the Permanent Solution Statement are presented below.

"On December 1, 2021, it was estimated that 60 gallons of diesel fuel was released from the saddle tank of a truck owned by Possum's Trucking. The truck rolled down the eastbound embankment of Harrison Boulevard in Avon, Massachusetts and struck a boulder. Diesel fuel impacted the soil beneath the vehicle and soil next to the boulder. Weather conditions were dry when the spill occurred; no surface water was affected. Due to staffing shortages, the first responders could only apply absorbents, and cover the affected soil with polyethylene sheeting. Fuel-impacted soil was subsequently removed and disposed of on January 6, and 10, 2022. The groundwater was impacted, but the native silty sediments and soil removal effort prevented significant groundwater migration. Once the diesel-impacted soil was recovered, significant migration was prevented. Field background chemical test results taken from the limits of the excavated area were all low or non-detect and below Method I Standards; background conditions have been approached. There is no significant risk to human health, public welfare, or the environment from the Site. All remediation waste has been removed and disposed at an approved facility, and a level of No Significant Risk has been reached Site, and the requirements for a Permanent Solution with No Conditions have been met."
