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### **NARRATIVE**

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Map D4, Block 3, Lot 6, is a residentially zoned, paved, grass and wooded 12,786+/- square foot lot, located on west side of West Main Street with a bordering vegetated wetland (BVW) on the western and southern parts of the property associated with a perennial stream (see Figure 1). The site has a residential building located in the eastern portion of the lot. According to the FIRM Town of Avon, Massachusetts, Norfolk County, Community Panel Number 25021C0381E, dated July 17, 2012, the applicable portion of the site is located in a Zone X. According to the MA OLIVER GIS MAP dated 10-23-20, the proposed activities are not located within the "Estimated Habitats of Rare Wildlife and Certified Vernal Pools" or the "Priority Habitats of Rare Species" (see Figure 2). The site is not located in an Area of Critical Environmental Concern.

The applicant is proposing the upgrade of a residential septic system for the existing residential home. The septic system design plan has been prepared by Collins Civil Engineering Group, Inc. titled, "Plan and Details Subsurface Sewage Disposal System Upgrade", dated: 10-21-20. The referenced plan is an attachment to this submittal.


The BVW in the vicinity of the proposed activities was delineated by Brooke Monroe, Botanist. The wetland flags were located using acceptable survey practices by Collins Civil Engineering Group, Inc.


An erosion control system consisting of a 12" composting silt sock is proposed around the work limits of the proposed project. Erosion controls will be as close as 27' to the BVW and the proposed septic tank will be 54' and SAS will be 52' from the BVW. These erosion control systems will effectively protect the wetland resource areas associated with this project. The erosion control system will be kept in place until all landscaping activities are complete and stabilized as stated in note 2 of the Wetland and Erosion Control Notes in the plan.

### ALTERNATIVE ANALYSIS

This property was subdivided prior to the 1996 River Protection Act and is an exempt activity form the Act. The septic system has been placed as far way form the river and wetland as possible. Any other location work be closing then what has been proposed.



### Dear George:

On September 3, 2020; in preparation for the proposed septic upgrade; I visited the above-referenced property (site) to delineate the boundary of the wetland resource area on/off the site. The resource areas are defined under Section 10.54, 10.56, 10.58 and 10.55 of the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act Regulations (310 CMR 10.00) (Regulations) and under the Town of Avon Wetlands Protection By-law as bank; land under a waterbody, riverfront area and bordering vegetated wetland (BVW), respectively. An un-named perennial stream ("river"); that flows from under West Main Street; was identified with pink flags labeled WF-1 thru MHW-6. The first 6 flags, which represent the bank of the stream; are the point of reference from which the 100 and 200-foot riverfront are measured on the site. The BVW; which is shown on the MassGis map; was identified by the continuation of the wetland flags from WF-7 to WF-17. The boundary of the BVW was identified by the presence of wetland/transitional plant species such as: red maple (Acer rubrum), Norway maple (Acer plantanoides), white pine (Pinus strobus) and white oak (Quercus alba) trees/saplings; common buckthorn (Rhamnus frangula), arrow-wood (Viburnum dentatum), green brier (Smilax glauca) and bittersweet (Celastrus orbiculata) in the shrub/vine layer; and spotted jewelweed (Impatiens capensis), poison ivy (Toxicodendron radicans), vinca (Vinca minor), sensitive fern (Onoclea sensibilis) and dewberry (Rubus hispidus) in the herbaceous layer.

According to the most recent Massachusetts Natural Heritage Atlas (NHESP, 14<sup>th</sup> Edition, August 1), 2017), the site is not mapped within priority/estimated habitat for rare species/wildlife and there are no certified vernal pools on the site.
